Darrell Lamme asked the status of the enclosure to hold salt. Wayne Hall said the enclosure is ready.

Dennis Smith discussed stray dogs and cats. Smith said it's a problem in Elwood. Smith discussed getting a kennel to hold the animals until Doniphan County Pet Rescue can pick them up. After a

discussion, Dennis Smith made the motion to get a kennel and set it up to hold stray animals. The other governing body members had questions: what if the pet rescue is full, where are we putting the kennel, who is responsible for feeding the animals, and what is the city's liability. The motion died due to lack of a second.
